VOLUNTEERING WITH **help2kids** IN TANZANIA AND MALAWI

Our volunteering programme offers you the unique opportunity to immerse yourself into the traditions of fascinating African countries. Join a young and dynamic team and experience the work of an NGO in Africa.





GENERAL

help2kids offers you the opportunity to discover the wonders of Africa and to live an unique experience in an aid organization. We have space for up to 15 volunteers in Tanzania and up to 14 volunteers at a time for our projects in Malawi throughout the year.

What makes volunteering with **help2kids** unique is the possibility to combine two very different countries that are still close to each other. You can volunteer for one or more months in Malawi and change later to Tanzania, or vice versa. Permit prices for volunteers in Tanzania and Malawi depend on the length of your stay so combining both countries may be a great way to save money.

REQUIREMENTS

Experience with children is an asset but not obligatory. Tell us your strengths, skills and interests. We have many projects and need different profiles, talents and competences. You should be at least 18 years old and willing to stay at least three weeks either in Tanzania or Malawi.

We are looking for motivated, flexible, adaptable, open-minded, communicative and pro-active volunteers who wish to immerse themselves into the African culture and traditions. While volunteering at **help2kids**, we ask that you try to keep an open mind to the new culture around you, as it is likely to be very different than your home country.

We want all of our volunteers to feel welcome and at home while living with us and we are happy to answer questions and offer advice on any issues. Tanzania and Malawi are wonderful countries, known for their friendly and hospitable people, and although each country has its difficulties, on the whole, these are wonderful places to live. We hope your volunteer experience with **help2kids** will be a rewarding, enjoyable and full of memorable moments.





VOLUNTEERING EXPERIENCE

Your tasks as a volunteer may include (according to project needs and your wishes):

- Teaching English and assisting the children with their work
- Teaching Reading, Writing, Mathematics, Computers, Sports, Songs, Games, Dance, and other fun learning activities
- Preparing lessons and activities in cooperation with the teachers
- Teaching IT / computer skills during holidays
- Assisting with classes at our Partner Primary School in smaller and bigger groups and one-on-one tutoring
- Volunteering at the health clinic in Malawi
- Working with our Tanzanian / Malawian staff at our projects
- Helping with household and administrative duties, such as cooking, gardening and smaller building works
- Participating in and/or planning field trips

We have different kinds of assignments and would be more than happy for you to help with them! You know more than you are aware of and we can use everyone willing to spend time with us, our children and projects.

Be creative and inspirational! If you have any preferences or wishes regarding your work – please let us know. Also tell us what you are interested in or if you have some special skills or knowledge which could be beneficial to our projects.

You will be part of an international team working with people from all over the world.

What can you do during the weekend? There are plenty of exciting leisure activities around our Voluntee Houses. Whether you want to relax at the beach, hike in the mountains or see wild animals on a safari, you will always find something to do. In our Volunteer Handbook you will find more detailed information about activities in the area.





ACCOMMODATION

We offer nice and comfortable accommodation at our Volunteer Houses.

In Tanzania the Volunteer House is located on the **help2kids** Campus, where we have 3 dorm rooms (a 6-bed and two 4-bed dormitories) as well as one private room. Our rooms have fans and share a bathroom and separate toilet. In Malawi we have two 6-bed dorm rooms that share a bathroom as well as private rooms and even a private cottage. All beds are equipped with mosquito nets.

At the Campus in Tanzania we offer wireless internet. In Malawi we offer pre-paid internet vouchers for less than USD 3 to pay on site. In Tanzania the cost of internet is 35 USD per month (a little over 1 USD a day) unlimited. We have a few bicycles, volunteers can use to travel to the projects in Tanzania (15–20min ride away), while in Malawi you can reach all of the projects within a 10–15 minute walk.

During your stay with us we can help you to organize safaris in Tanzania's beautiful National Parks like Serengeti, Lake Manyara, Ngorongoro Crater and many more as well as hiking trips to the mountains and holidays on Zanzibar. In Malawi we have a partnership with a local tour operator, offering trips and excursions that include Cape McClear Nature Reserve and Mulanje Mountain Reserve. They offer special rates exclusively for our volunteers and guests.





COSTS

* Above weekly cost excludes the USD 200 admin fee (single payment)

The costs include accommodation in one of our dormitories (4–6 people), breakfast and in Malawi also lunch, room cleaning, and security. In-country support and coordinating your volunteering placement at the different projects costs USD 200.

Our international management team on-site will always be present and take care of you. Travel costs, visa, permits and insurance are at the expense of the volunteers. If you would like, we can arrange a pick-up at the airport for USD 30 in Tanzania and for USD 90 in Malawi.

There are also private rooms available at the Volunteer Houses. If you wish to stay in a private room we can give you a specific quote on request (depending on availability and season).

In Tanzania breakfast is provided 7 days per week and for a small extra fee you can get lunch on our Campus. In Malawi we provide you with breakfast every day and lunch from Monday to Friday. Our Volunteerhouses have well-equipped kitchens where our volunteers can prepare their own meals in the evening and on the weekends.

We ask our volunteers to pay a non-refundable deposit of USD 300 in advance before their arrival in Dar es Salaam or Lifuwu, in order to secure their volunteer place (deposit will be deducted from your final invoice).
